is offered on Tuesdays as a fruit choice when available.



Students may take ALL fruit and vegetable choices offered daily, if they choose.

(NSLP) are as follows...students will be offered 5 meal components daily. The daily components will consist of...grains, meat/meat alternates, vegetables, **fruits and fluid milk**. Each student may take all 5 components or as few as 3 components to receive a reimbursable meal. If a student chooses to take only 3 components, one component **MUST** be a **fruit** or a **vegetable** for the meal to be a reimbursable meal. A student may take as little as ½ cup serving of a fruit and/or vegetable or as much as a 1 cup serving of a fruit and/or a vegetable. Students may take **ALL fruit** and **vegetable** choices offered daily, if they

choose.



Students **MUST** take at least 3 of the 5 components offered daily, one of the 3 items taken **MUST** be a **fruit** or a vegetable.
